

Based on long-term ethnographic research in the art worlds of Istanbul and Berlin, **Dr. Banu Karaca's** book "The National Frame" rethinks the politics of art by focusing on the role of art in state governance. Examining discussions of the civilizing function of art in Turkey and Germany and particularly moments in which art is seen to cede this function, the book reveals the histories of violence on which the production, circulation, and the very understanding of art are predicated.

Dr. Banu Karaca is an EUME Fellow of the Volkswagen Foundation at the Forum Transregionale Studien, Berlin.
